

Process of Downloading the SAWBO Animation You Want:

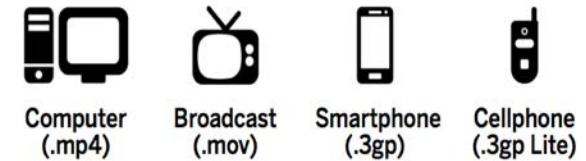
1. Choose the animation topic you want (click on image)



2. Choose the language you want (from the drop down menu)



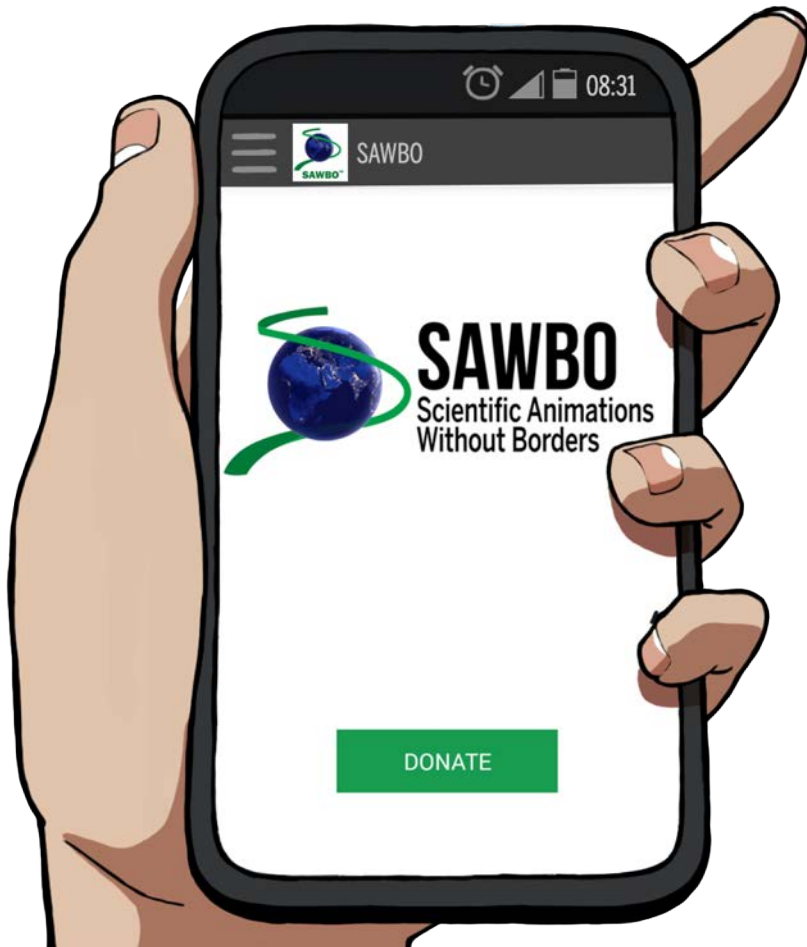
3. Choose the file type you want (click on image) to download the animation



4. Use it in your educational program as you see fit



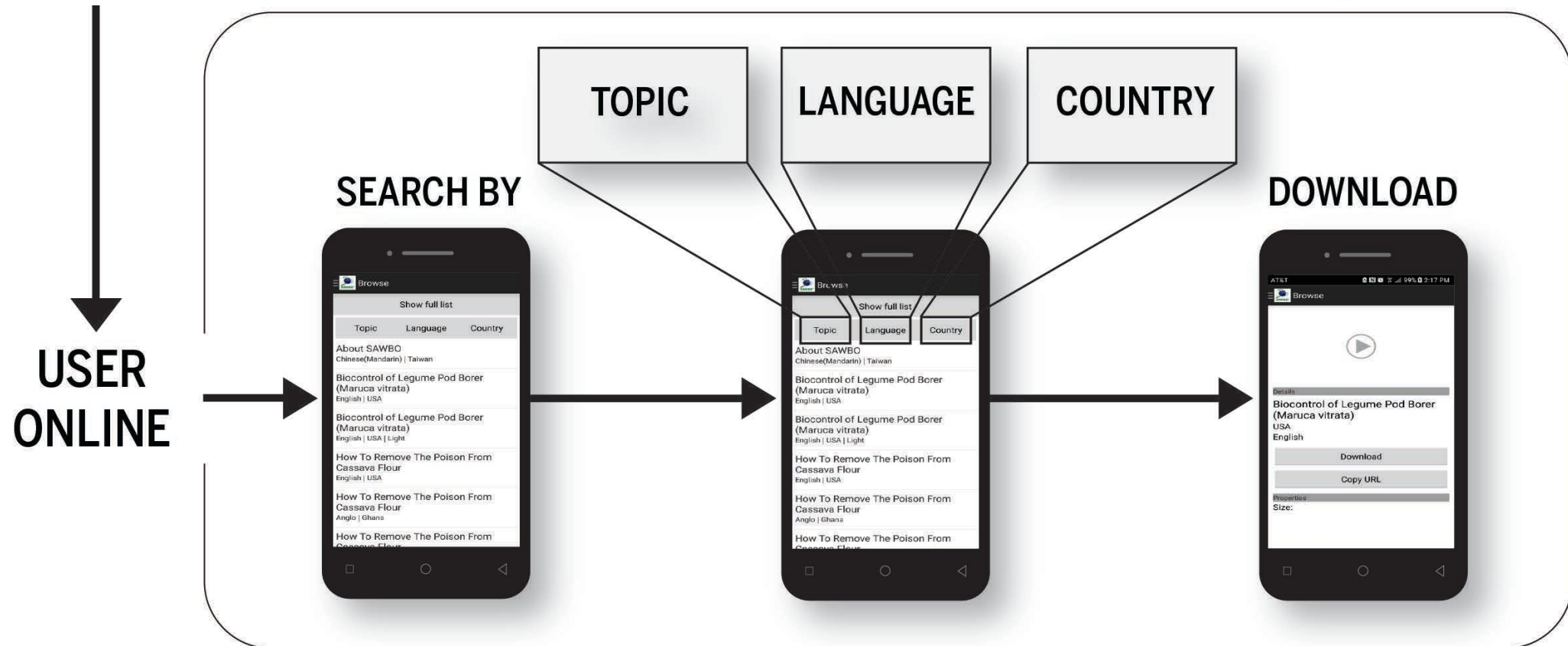

- **Show or share (by Bluetooth) the downloaded animations when and where you want**

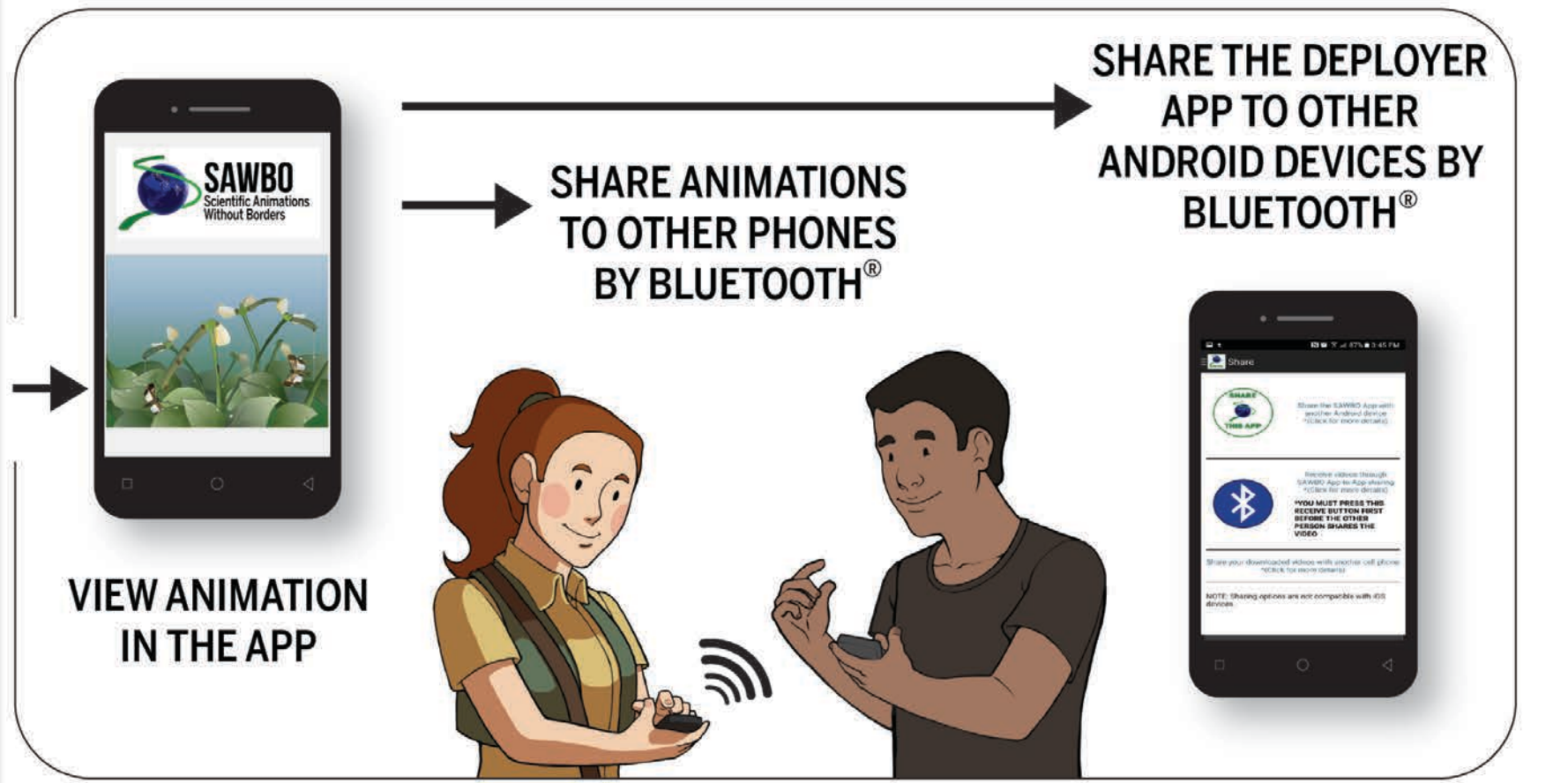
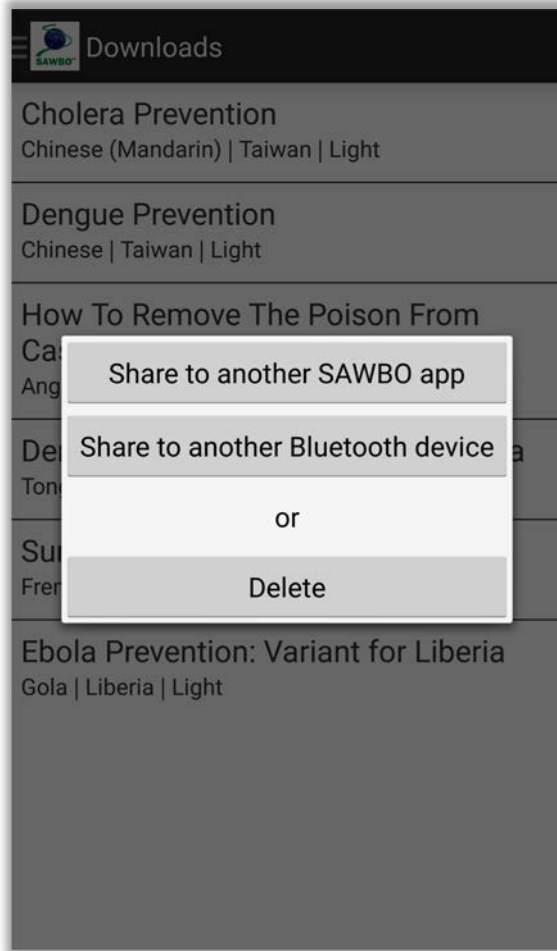


Viewing on the app in the field (offline)



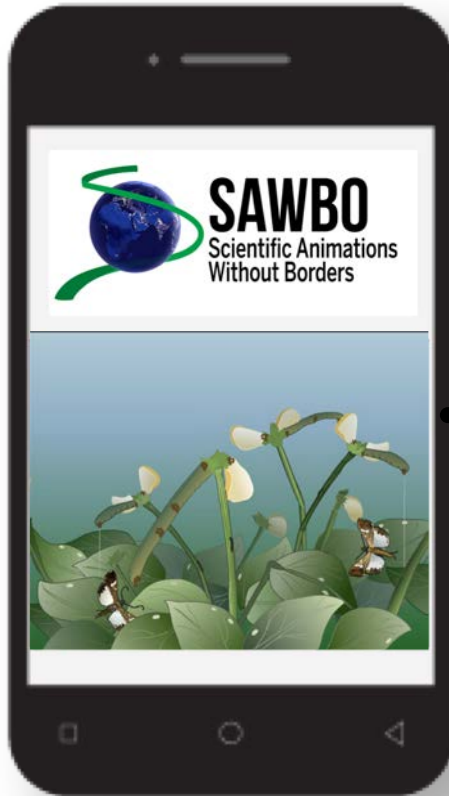
